Determined, Kiera, Kian and their Burmon set off to find the seed.





















"There it is!" Kiera smiles as she sees the cave from afar. They begin running towards it when stopped abruptly by a voice in the wind.

"Fine. I only wanted it so I can trade for some coins anyway."


Just like that, Kiera is reunited with Panalem and ready to go home.
